

## ■ SPECIFICATION OF POLARITY TO PREVENT INCORRECT INSERTION

- Specify polarity as follows:
- Header (pin type, clip type)

Basic part number
Common
Pin number with pin polarity
Example

00: No polarity


When the A2 key is not used, only the basic part number is specified without a suffix.

04: Pin 4 is cut or pulled out.


Position of clip type polarity (see the figure on the right)

Note: The standard specification is #04 or the end pin number (if the end pin is 50, the specification is 50).


• Socket (pin type)



Note: The specification method is the same for IDC plugs and through hole sockets.
