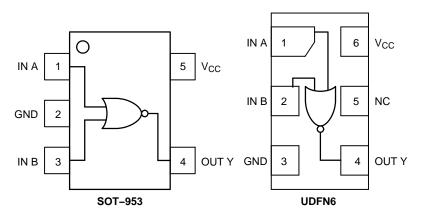

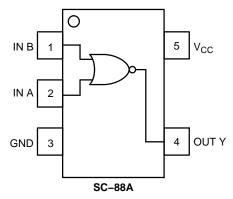


Figure 1. Pinout (Top View)

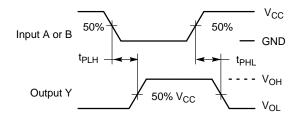
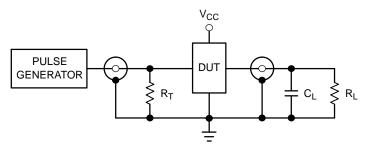


Figure 3. Switching Waveforms

Figure 4. Test Circuit

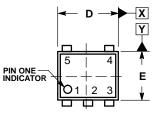
