






Figure 3. DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current

Figure 4. Base Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. **Collector Current**





Figure 5. Base Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. **Collector Current**

Figure 6. Base Emitter Turn-On Voltage vs. **Collector Current**



Figure 8. Input Capacitance






Figure 9. Output Capacitance

Figure 10. Safe Operating Area








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
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
