#### DESCRIPTION

The 74LV377 is a low-voltage CMOS device and is pin and function compatible with 74HC/HCT377.

The 74LV377 has eight edge-triggered, D-type flip-flops with individual D inputs and Q outputs. A common clock (CP) input loads all flip-flops simultaneously when the data enable  $(\overline{E})$  is LOW. The state of each D input, one set-up time before the LOW-to-HIGH clock transition, is transferred to the corresponding output (Q<sub>n</sub>) of the flip-flop. The E input must be stable only one set-up time prior to the LOW-to-HIGH transition for predictable operation.

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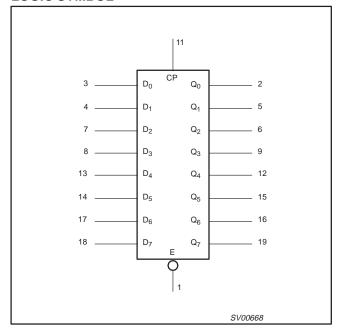

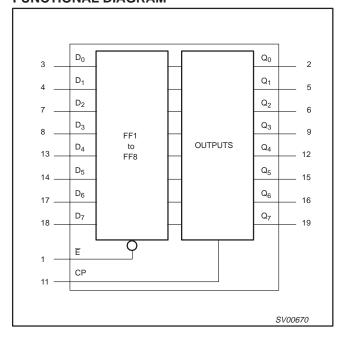
### LOGIC SYMBOL (IEEE/IEC)

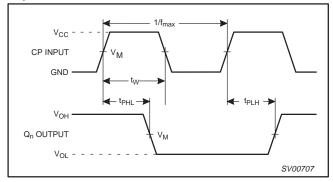


Figure 1. Clock (CP) to output  $(Q_n)$  propagation delays, the clock pulse width and the maximum clock pulse frequency.

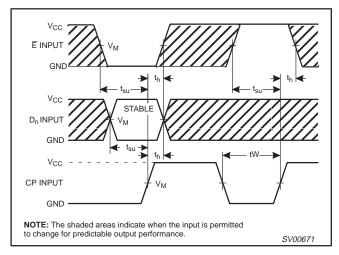


Figure 2. Data set-up and hold times from the data input (Dn) and from the enable input (E) to the clock (CP).

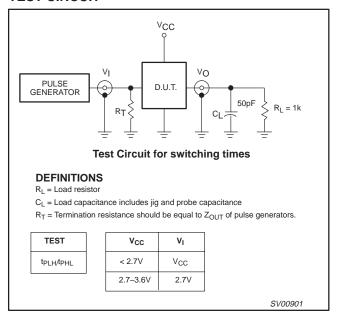
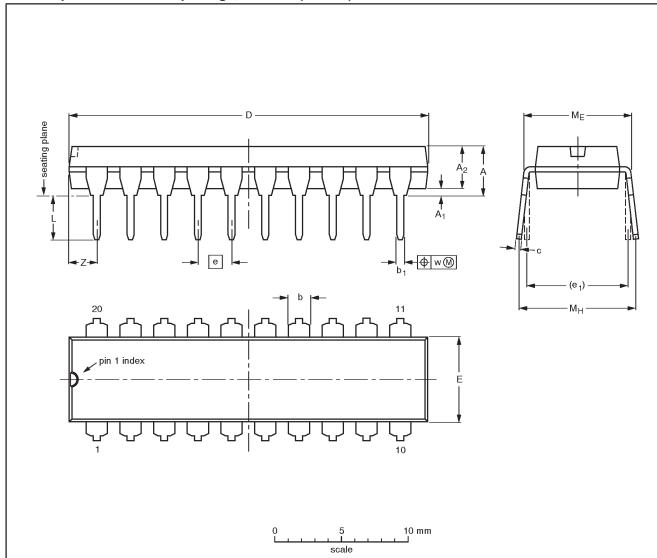


Figure 3. Load circuitry for switching times
