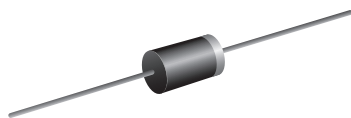

TYPICAL APPLICATIONS

For use in general purpose rectification of power supplies, inverters, converters and freewheeling diodes.

Case: DO-41 (DO-204AL), molded epoxy over glass body

Molding compound meets UL 94 V-0 flammability rating
Base P/N-E3 - RoHS-compliant, commercial grade

Terminals: matte tin plated leads, solderable per J-STD-002 and JESD 22-B102

E3 suffix meets JESD 201 class 1A whisker test

Polarity: color band denotes cathode end

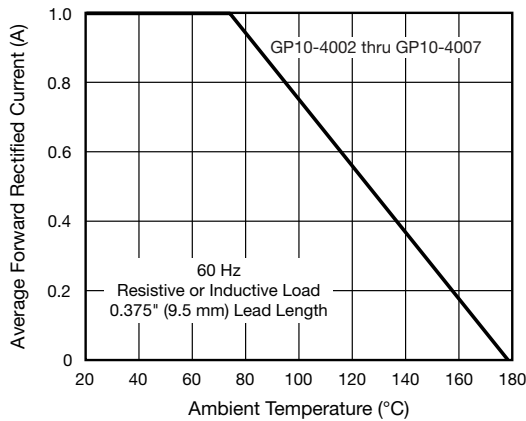
RATINGS AND CHARACTERISTICS CURVES ($T_A = 25\text{ }^{\circ}\text{C}$ unless otherwise noted)

Fig. 1 - Forward Current Derating Curve

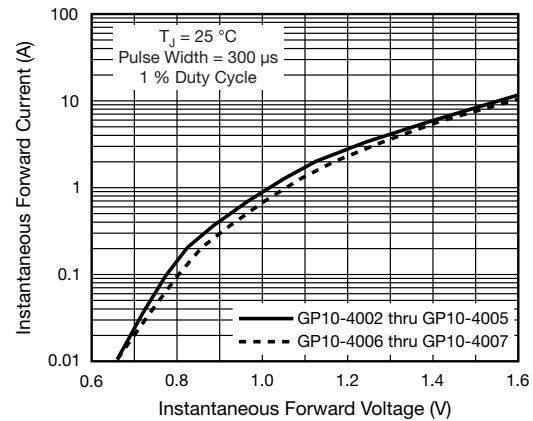


Fig. 3 - Typical Instantaneous Forward Characteristics

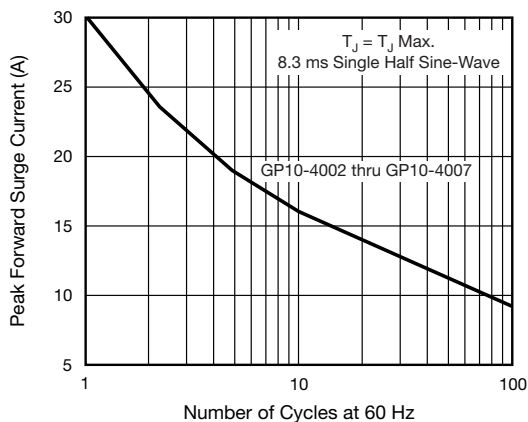


Fig. 2 - Maximum Non-repetitive Peak Forward Surge Current

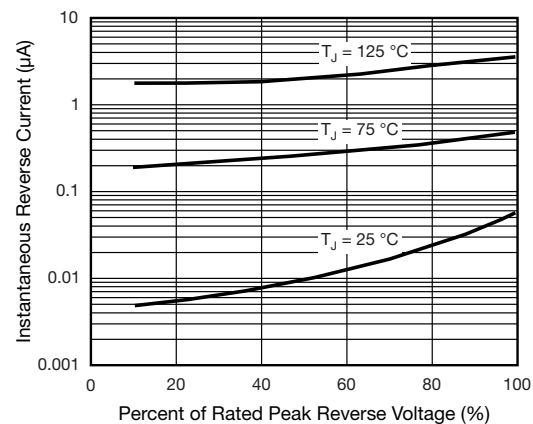


Fig. 4 - Typical Reverse Characteristics

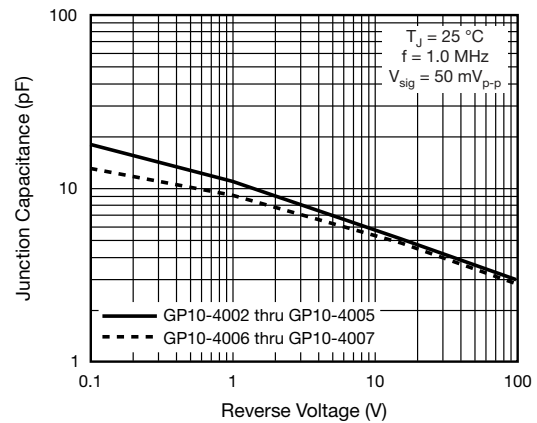
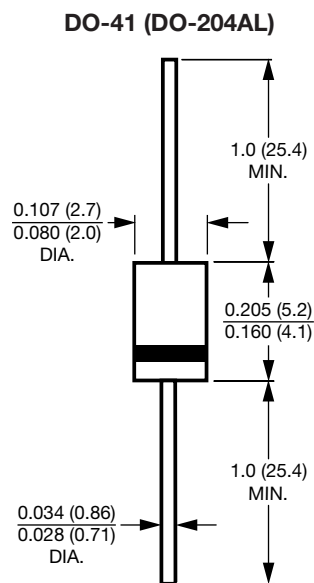


Fig. 5 - Maximum Repetitive Peak Reverse Voltage, V_{RRM}
