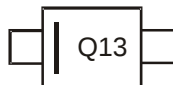

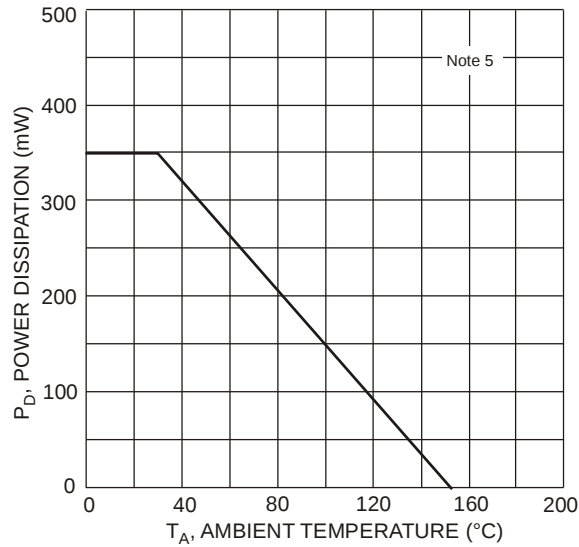


Figure 1 Power Derating Curve

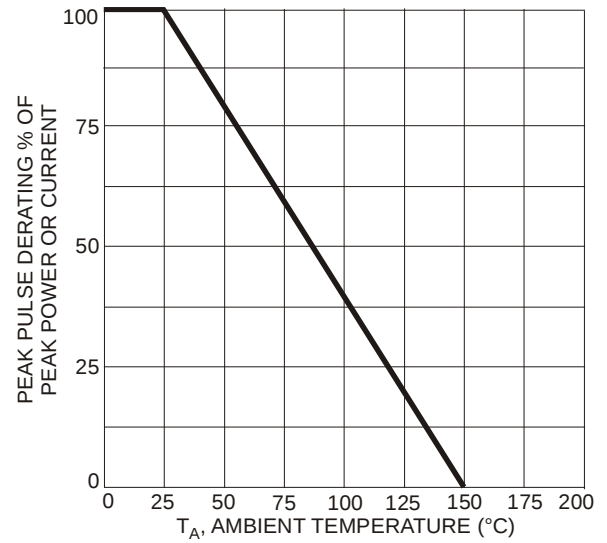


Figure 2 Pulse Derating Curve

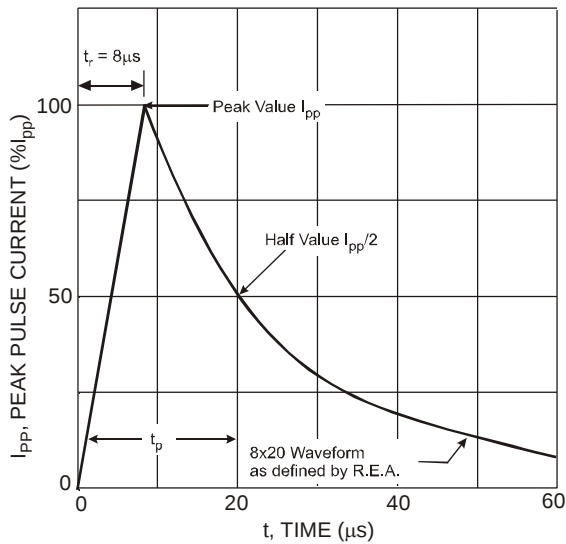


Figure 3 Typical 8 x 20 μs Pulse Waveform

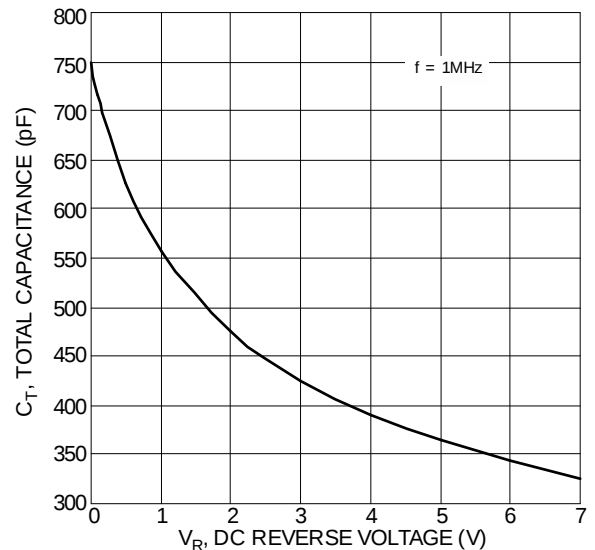
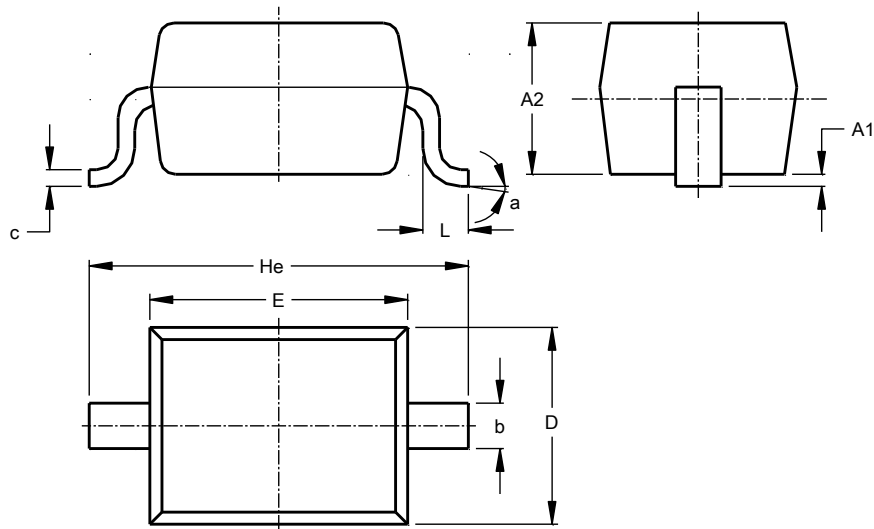


Figure 4 Typical Junction Capacitance

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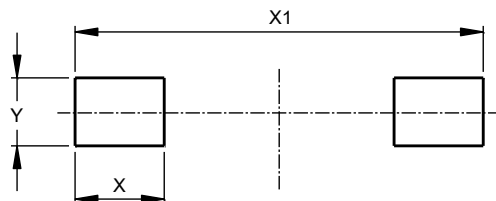
