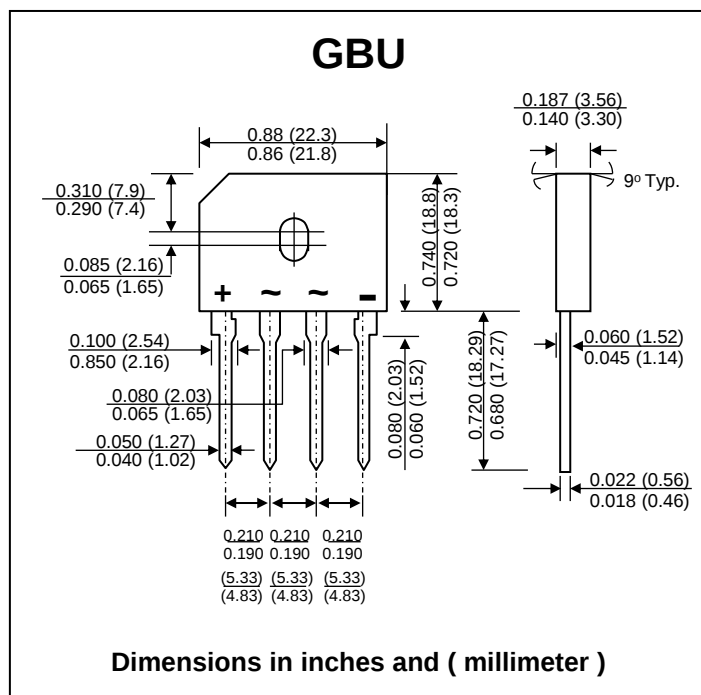

FIG.1 - DERATING CURVE FOR OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT

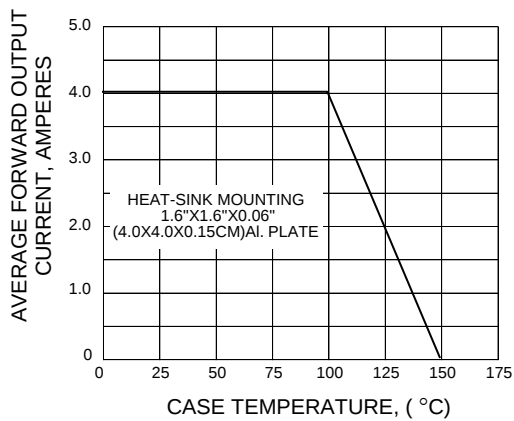


FIG.2 - MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT PER LEG

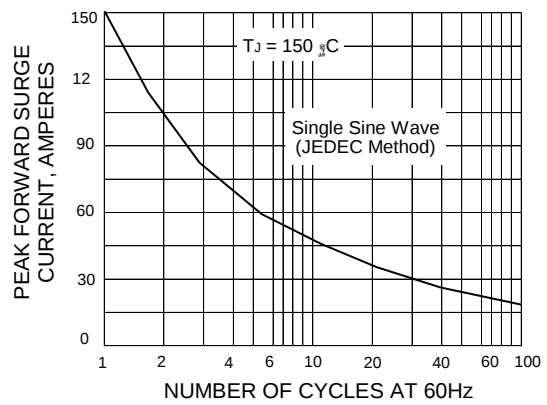


FIG.3 - TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG

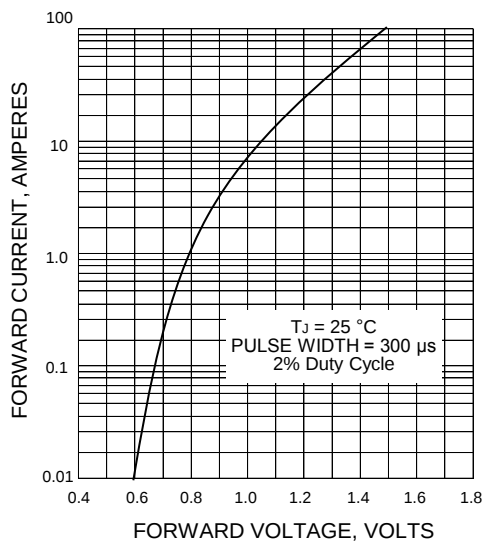


FIG.4 - TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG
