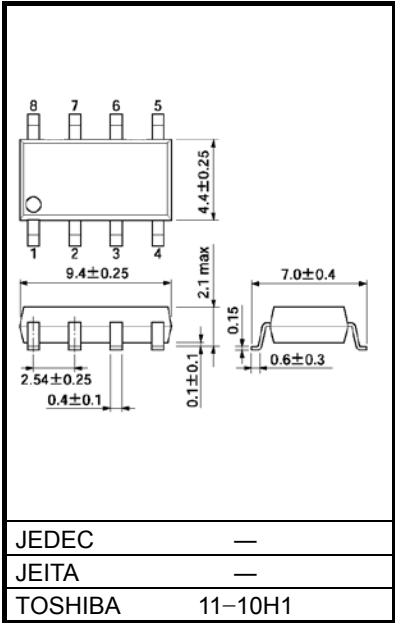
The TOSHIBA TLP3125 consists of a gallium arsenide infrared-emitting diode optically coupled to a photo-MOSFET in a SOP, which is suitable for surface mount assembly.

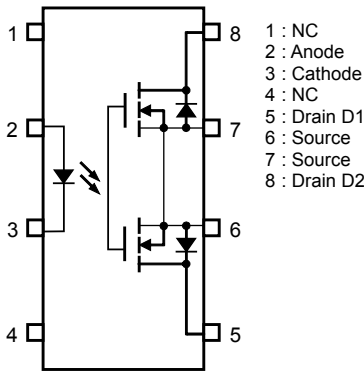

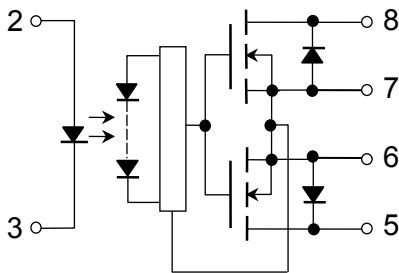
