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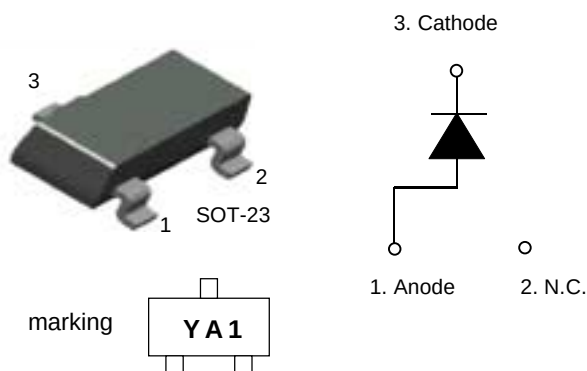

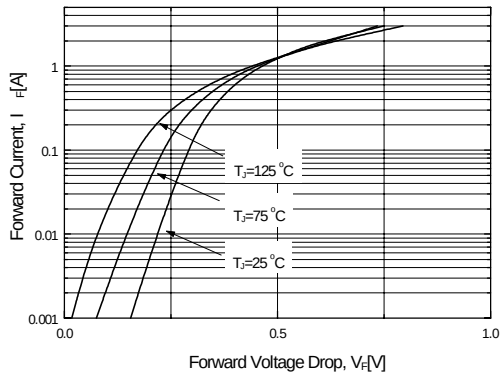


Figure 1. Typical Forward Voltage Characteristics

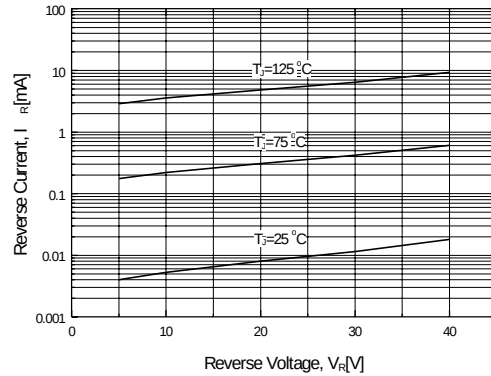


Figure 2. Typical Reverse Current vs. Reverse Voltage

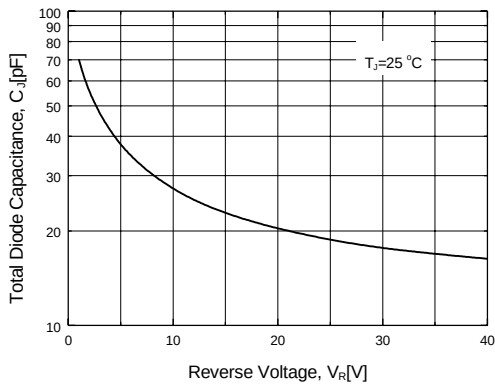


Figure 3. Total Diode Capacitance

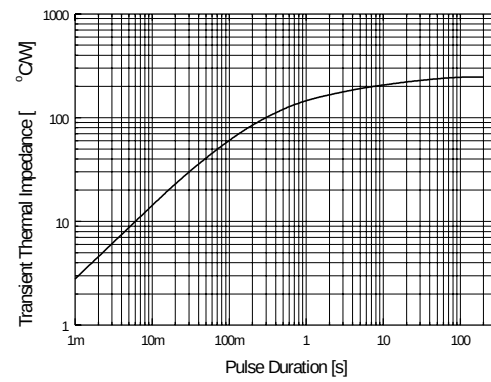


Figure 4. Thermal Impedance Characteristics

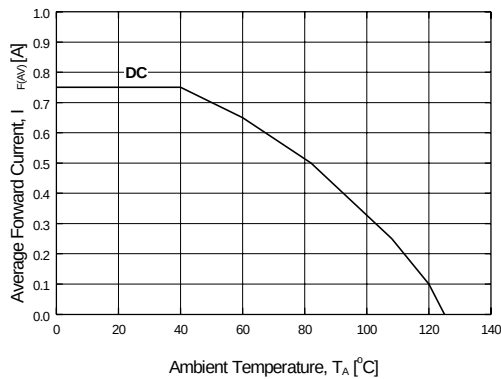


Figure 5. Forward Current Derating Curve

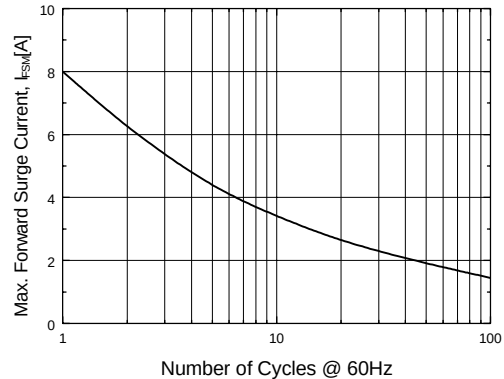
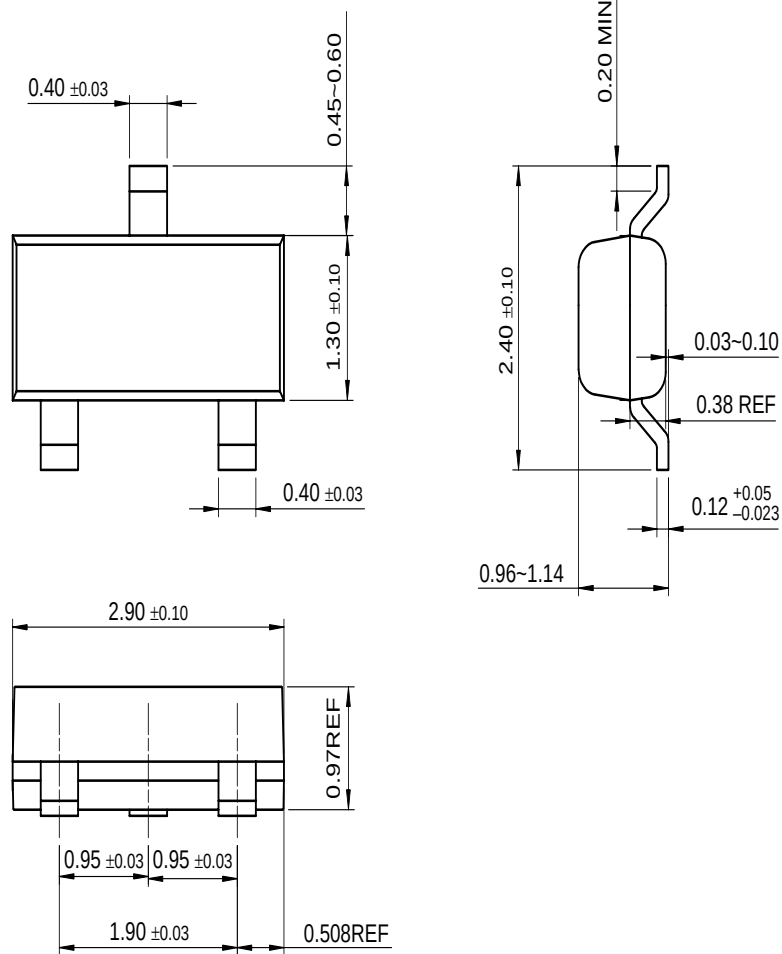


Figure 6. Non-Repetitive Surge Current
