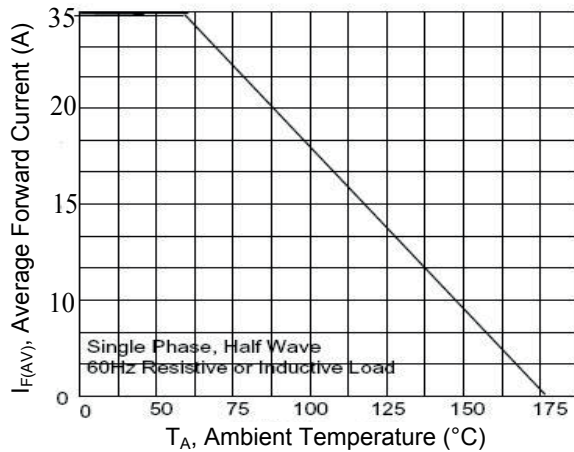


Figure1. Derating Curve for Output Rectifier Current

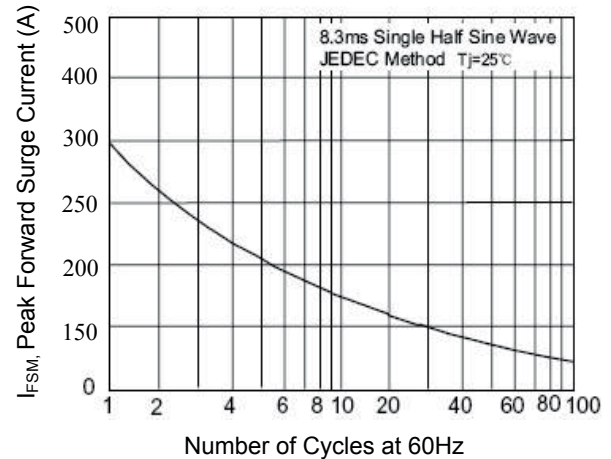


Figure 2. Maximum Non-Repetitive Peak Forward Surge Current

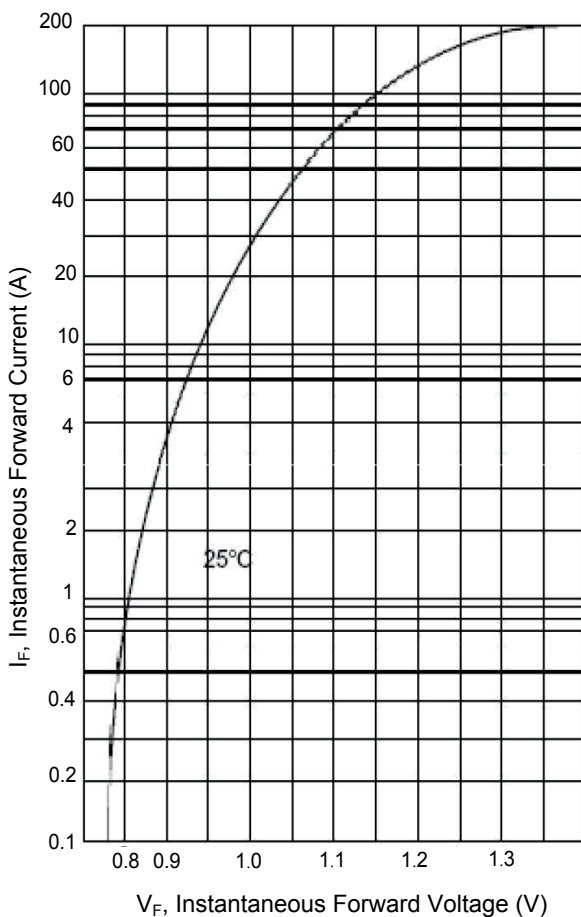


Figure 3. Typical Instantaneous Forward Characteristics

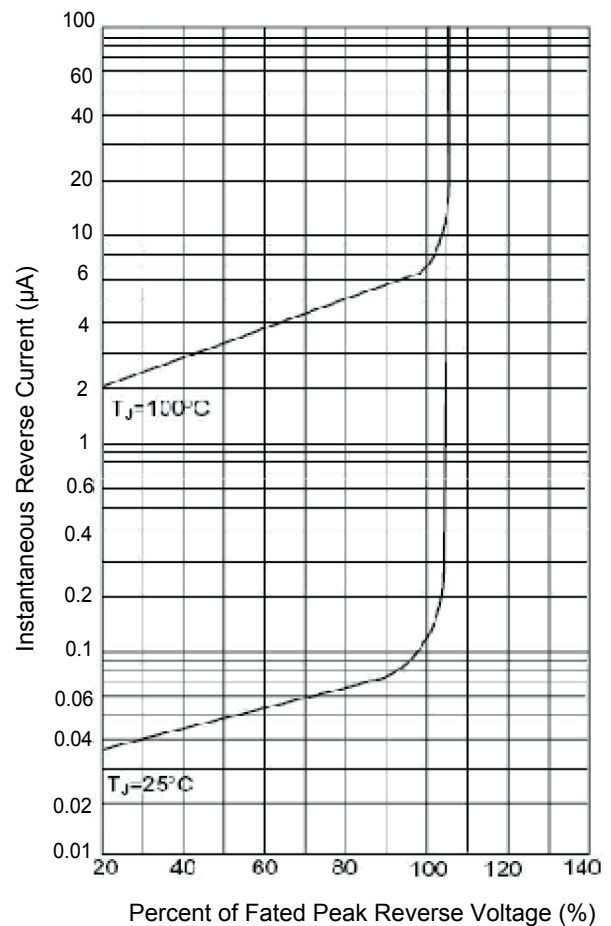
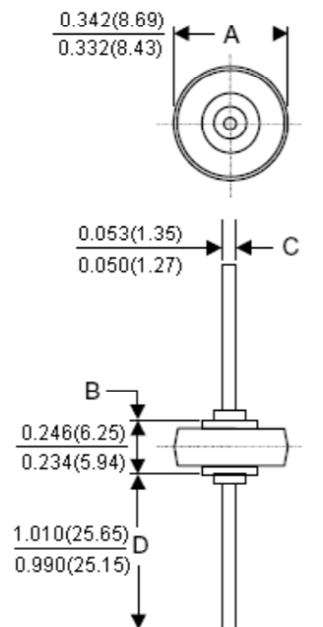


Figure 4. Typical Reverse Characteristics
