


Figure 1. 8-Lead Pinout (Top View) and Logic Diagram




Figure 2. F_{max} Typical




Figure 3. Typical Termination for Output Driver and Device Evaluation (See Application Note <u>AND8020/D</u> – Termination of ECL Logic Devices)


