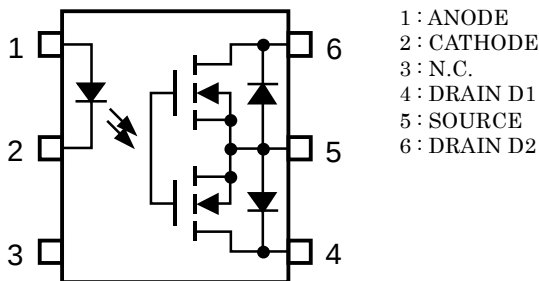

The TLP597A is a bi-directional switch can replace mechanical relays in many applications.

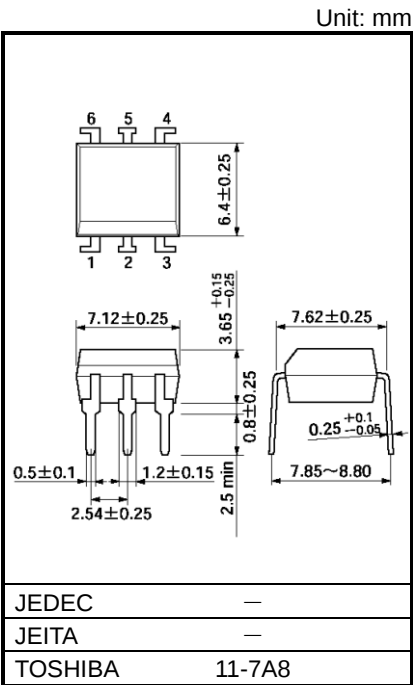
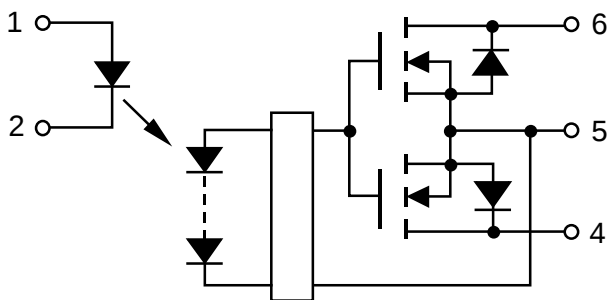
