Description

There are total 5 pins on the encoders, 3 of them on one side are for rotary encoding which need a simple circuit to supply DC 5V. The remaining 2 pin go short whenever pressed. Please refer to **example scheme** for more clear understanding.

In the middle of 3 pins' side is COM port connect to $\ensuremath{\mathsf{GND}}$.

And other pins (A and B same side of GND) separate pull to +5v via 10k ohm resisters

Connect the A and B directly to Arduino IO pins.
