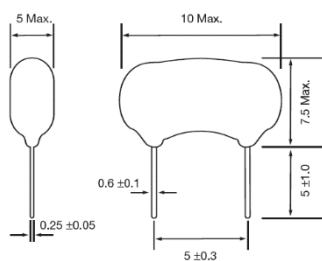


Figure 1) ZTA□.□□MG Side and Front Views

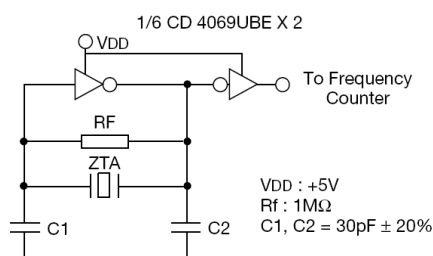


Figure 2) ZTA□.□□MG Test Circuit

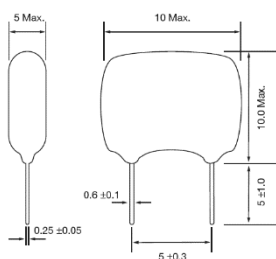


Figure 3) ZTA□.□□MT, MX Side and Front Views

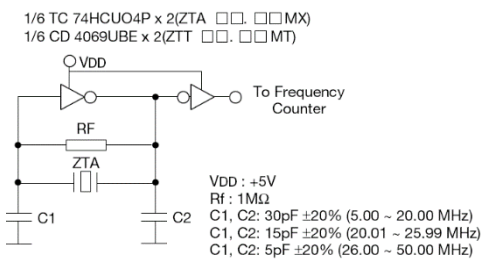


Figure 4) ZTA□.□□MT & ZTA□.□□MX Test Circuit
