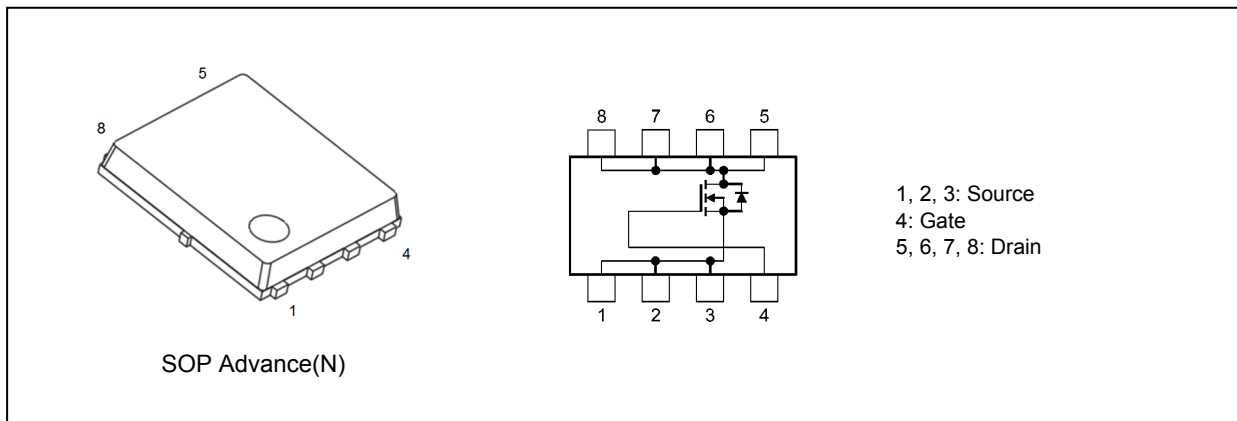

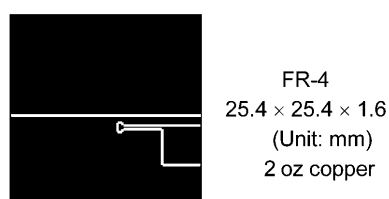


Fig. 5.1 Device Mounted on a Glass-Epoxy Board (a)

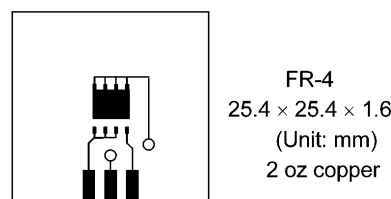


Fig. 5.2 Device Mounted on a Glass-Epoxy Board (b)

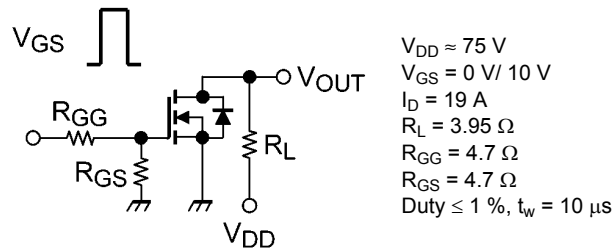


Fig. 6.2.1 Switching Time Test Circuit

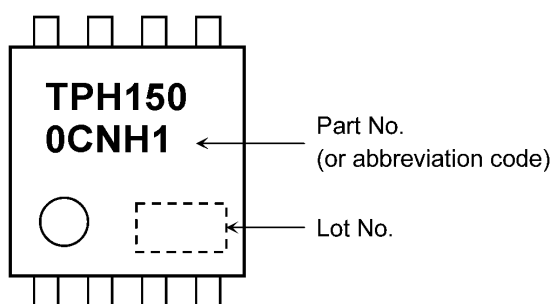


Fig. 7.1 Marking

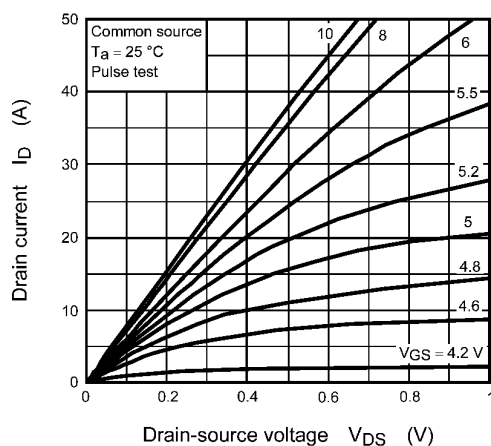


Fig. 8.1 ID - VDS

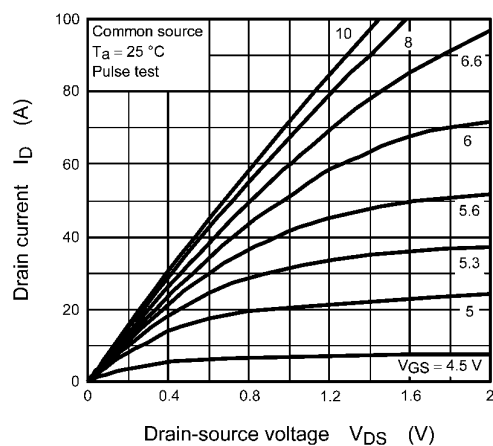


Fig. 8.2 ID - VDS

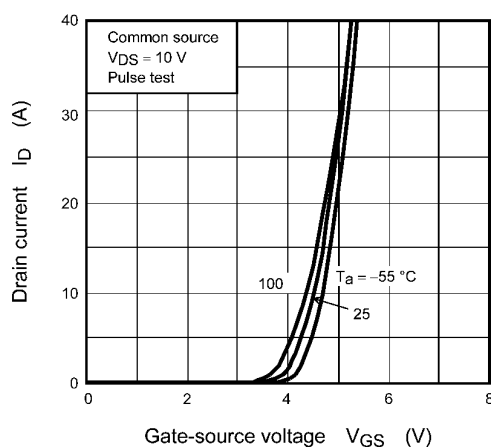


Fig. 8.3 ID - VGS

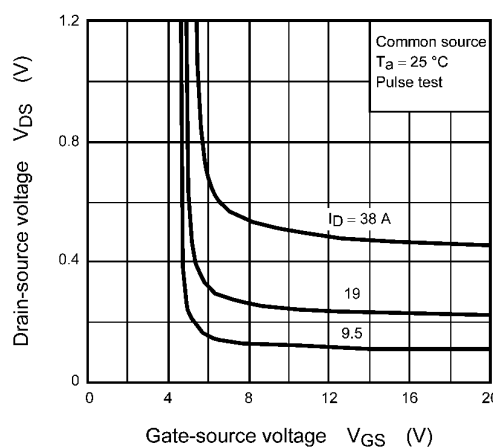


Fig. 8.4 VDS - VGS

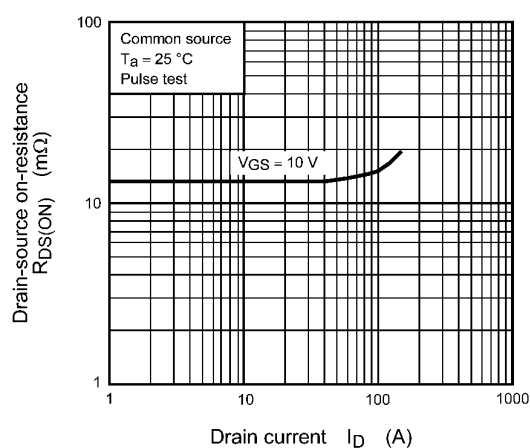


Fig. 8.5 RDS(ON) - ID

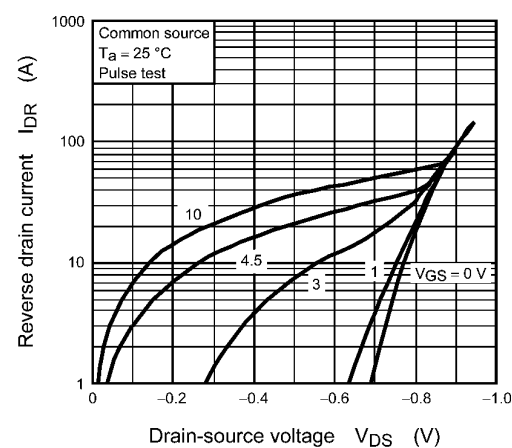


Fig. 8.6 IDR - VDS

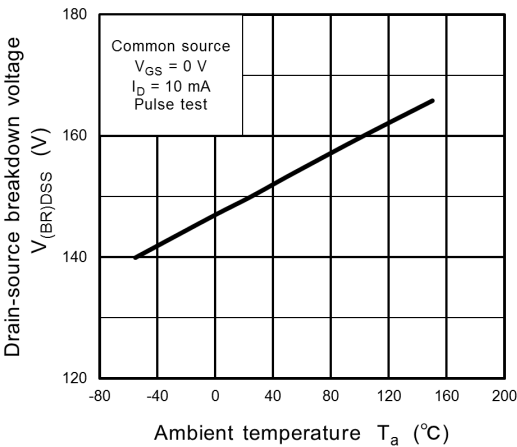


Fig. 8.7 $V_{(BR)DSS} - T_a$

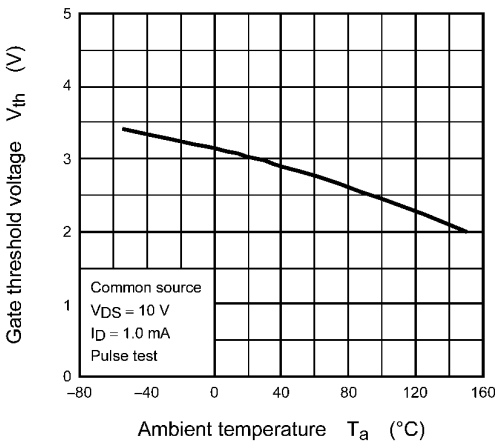


Fig. 8.8 $V_{th} - T_a$

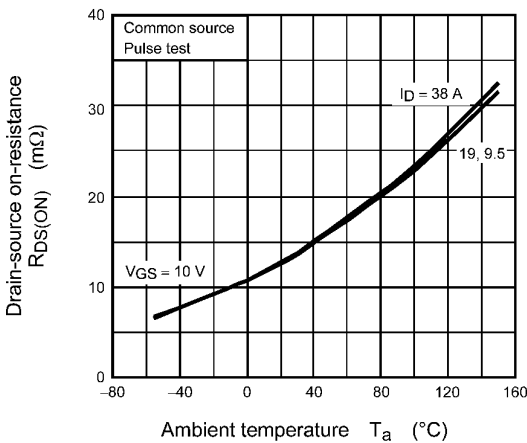


Fig. 8.9 $R_{DS(ON)} - T_a$

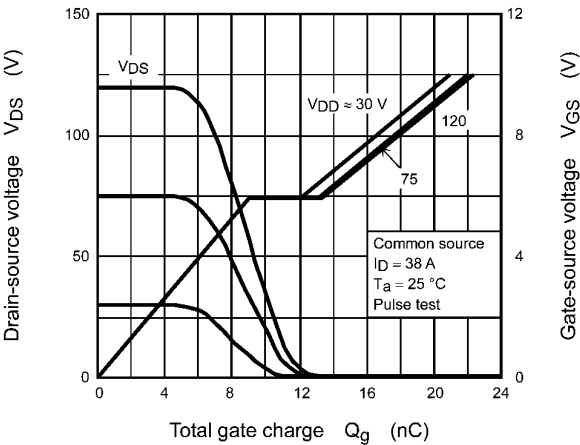


Fig. 8.10 Dynamic Input/Output Characteristics

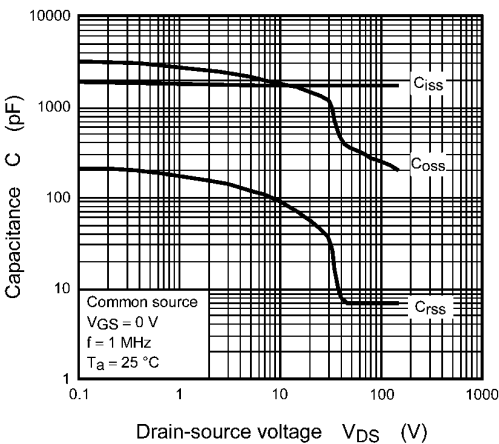


Fig. 8.11 Capacitance - V_{DS}

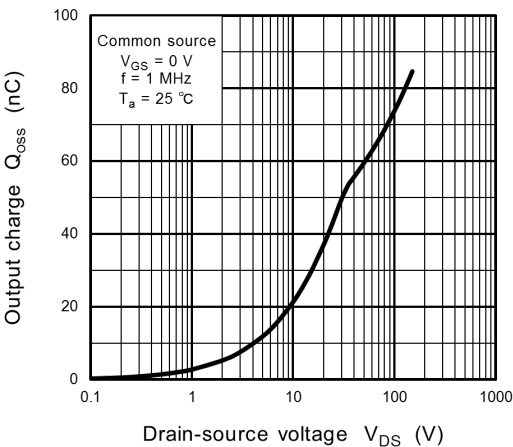


Fig. 8.12 $Q_{oss} - V_{DS}$

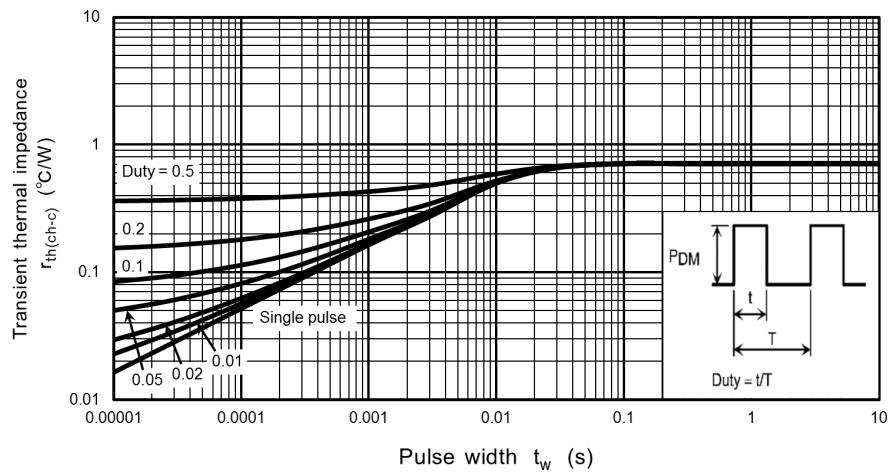


Fig. 8.13 $r_{th} - t_w$
(Guaranteed Maximum)

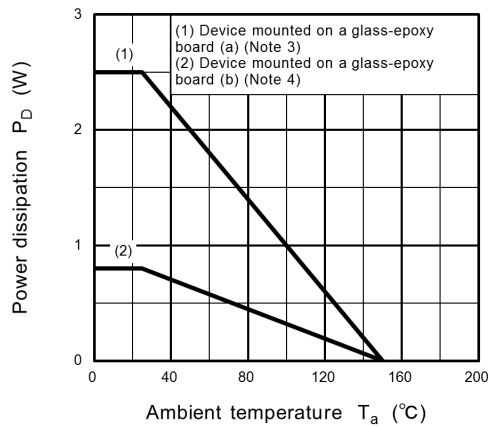


Fig. 8.14 $P_D - T_a$
(Guaranteed Maximum)

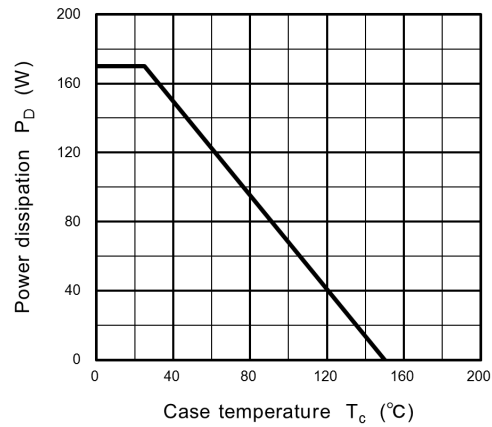


Fig. 8.15 $P_D - T_c$
(Guaranteed Maximum)

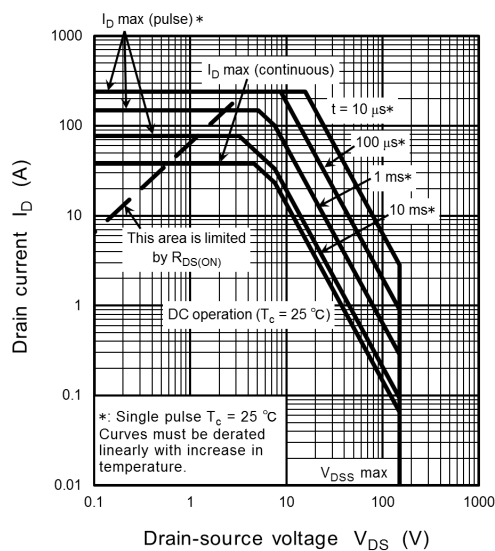
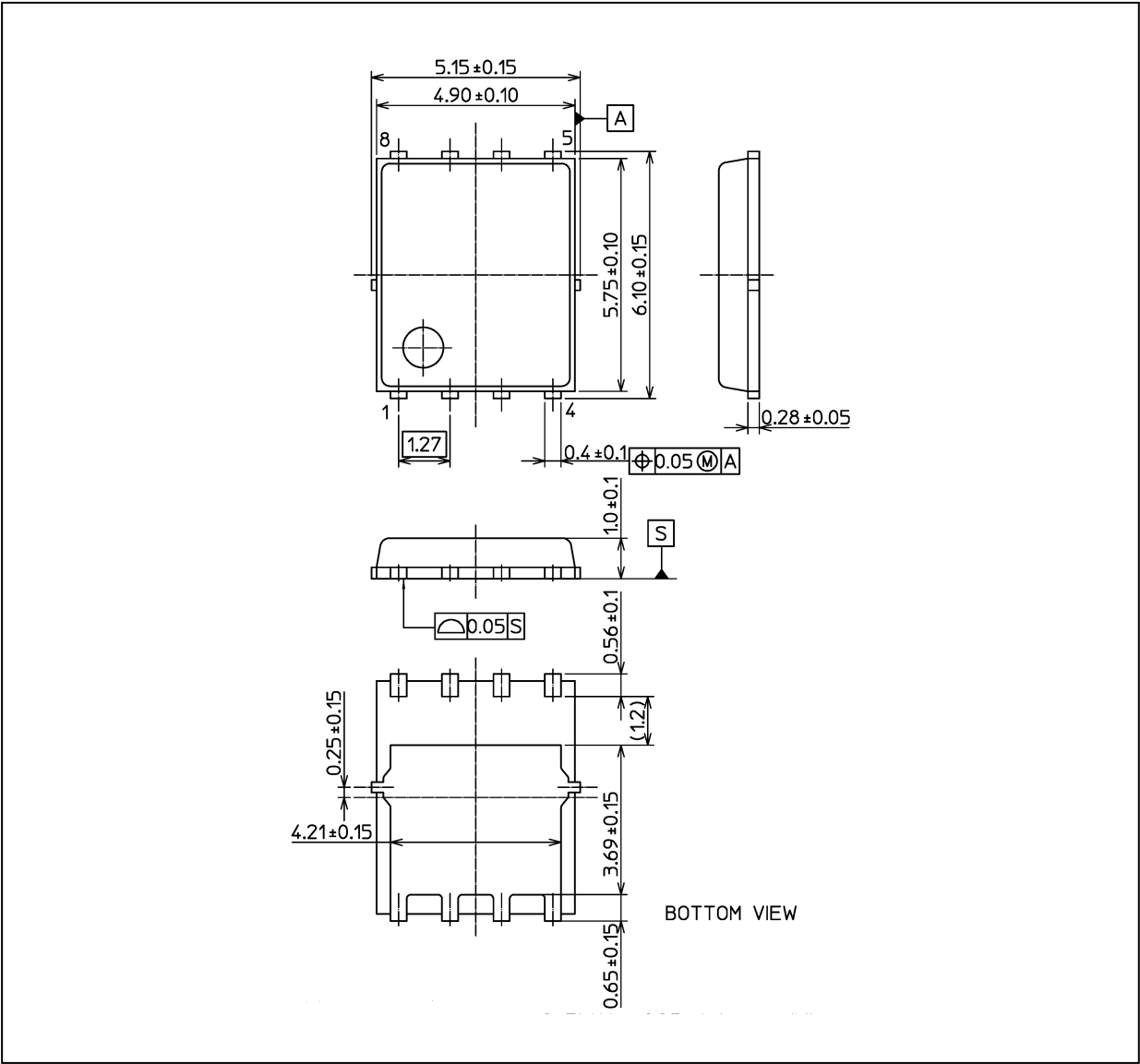


Fig. 8.16 Safe Operating Area
